EZRA: ITS PLACE IN THE BIBLE STORY

The back-story

722BC Northern kingdom falls to Shalamaneser (2 Kings 17.1-23) and Samaria resettled (2 Kings 17.24-41). This will be important for understanding Ezra 4. Esarhaddon is a later king of Assyria (2 Kings 20.37).

606BC Nebuchadnezzar first attacks Jerusalem (Daniel and his friends carried off?)(2 Chr 36.6)


597BC Nebuchadnezzar removes King Jehoiachin in Jerusalem (2 Chr 36.9-10)


586BC Nebuchadnezzar demolished Jerusalem (2 Chr 36.18-20). Full exile begins

562BC Evil-Merodach becomes king in Nebuchadnezzar's place (2 Ki 25.27-30)

556BC Nabonidus, last king of Babylon (not mentioned in the Bible). Interested in religious affairs, so left the running of his kingdom to son Belshazzar (hence why Daniel is made 'third' in the kingdom, see Daniel 5.29)


Building a timeline/The Bible story
